





## Our Featured French Vineyards

### *Maison Louis Jadot*

Formed by Louis Henry Denis Jadot in 1859, Louis Jadot's philosophy is based on one simple vision: "to maintain the grandeur of Burgundy for all time". They are one of the most prestigious houses in Burgundy, producing a vast portfolio of superb wines, representing nearly every appellation, straddling entry level and fine wines with the same attention to detail devoted to all.

#### **Bourgogne Chardonnay Couvent des Jacobins 2019**

8.75 / 11.65 / 35

*Chardonnay*

A perfect introduction to the delights and complexity of real white Burgundy, fresh with lovely weight, delicate creaminess and judicious oak making this a beautifully balanced dry white.

#### **Chassagne-Montrachet 2016**

70

*Chardonnay*

The pinnacle of white Burgundy. A balanced combination of fat rich butter and steely, flinty, mineral elegance. Toasted almond and toffee notes mingle into ripe lemon and pear in this silky, cream-textured white.

#### **Bourgogne Pinot Noir Couvent des Jacobins 2019**

8.75 / 11.65 / 35

*Pinot Noir*

An affordable entry into the world of Burgundy. Aromas of red and black berry fruits on the nose, combined with a light supple body, allow this wine to punch well above its weight.

### *M. Chapoutier*



M. Chapoutier is one of the Rhône's most famous and established producers. The company produces an incredibly broad range of wines at every price point. He was among the first to focus on single-site wines and championed a new style with low yields and ageing in new French oak. "Wine comes from the sky and the earth... And from the love we have for it."

#### **Crozes-Hermitage, Petite Ruche 2019**

38

*Syrah*

An intense purple-red body and a nose of red berries, blackcurrant, and raspberry. The palate has plenty of ripe fruit and finesse to finish.



## Red Wines

### Australia

**St Hallett Faith 2020**

7.75 / 10 / 30

*Shiraz*

*Barossa*

The nose shows notes of dark cherry, hints of chocolate and spice; dark fruits follow on the palate entwined with pepper spice and a savoury finish with soft tannins.

### Chile

**Errázuriz 1870 Teno Block 2019**

6.50 / 8.65 / 26

*Merlot*

*Curicó Valley, Casablanca*

In the Curicó region, warm summers and plentiful sunshine ripen the Merlot grapes to produce a wine with a juicy plum fruit character which shows hints of oak and smooth tannins on the finish.

### France

**Château Pontet Bayard, Montagne-Saint-Émilion 2018** 30

*Merlot, Cabernet Franc*

*Bordeaux*

The palate is fruity, well-balanced and offers a juicy/finely acidulous frame. The wine is concentrated, with firm, chewy tannins, plump fruit and shows a typical right-bank profile.

**Moulin d'Issan Bordeaux Supérieur 2017**

32

*Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot*

*Bordeaux*

The blend is 50% Cabernet Sauvignon and 50% Merlot, and the vines average age is just under 20 years. Medium-bodied, it shows plum, blackberry and crème de cassis flavours.

**Louis Jadot Fleurie Poncereau 2020**

34

*Gamay*

*Burgundy*

Mellow, elegant but also racy, it has a silky texture with plenty of ripe red fruit. This wine is aged in oak barrels for around nine months before bottling

### Italy

**Bolla Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2016** 42

*Corvina, Rondinella*

*Valpolicella, Veneto*

A blend of Corvina, Corvinone and Rondinella grapes, matured in oak barrels for three years and a further year in bottle. A complex perfume of black cherry, raisin and cedar spice with balsamic hints and a long, elegant finish.

**Feudi Salentini Primitivo del Manduria Gocce 2017** 36

*Primitivo*

*Manduria*

Bares a rounded palate with a bouquet reminiscent of wild berries and notes of caramel. The finish is smooth and rich with ripe fruit flavours appearing alongside spicy aromatic notes.

**Enrico Serafino Barolo 2016**

42

*Nebbiolo*

*Piedmonte*

This wine hosts an intensely elegant nose, with red fruit and spicy notes of liquorice and vanilla. An austere palate with smooth tannins complements a freshness to the finish.

**San Salvatore Jungano Aglianico 2017**

39

*Aglianico*

*Paestum*

This organic spicy red is made from the indigenous Aglianico grape. The nose shows integrated fresh ripe mulberry and hedgerow fruit with spicy, cinnamon oak on the finish.

### New Zealand

**Vidal Reserve Pinot Noir 2018**

30

*Pinot Noir*

*Marlborough*

Aged in French oak over winter, 10% new. Fragrant with red berry and floral aromas, with notes of cherry and spice on the silky palate.

### Portugal

**Esporão Alandra Tinto 2020**

6 / 8 / 24

*Moreto, Castela, Trincadeira*

*Alentejo*

Fresh, savoury, berry-fruit aromas on the nose, this medium to full-bodied wine has good acidity and a surprisingly long and gripping finish.

### South Africa

**Flagstone Longitude 2018**

28

*Shiraz-Cabernet Sauvignon-Petit Verdot*

*Western Cape*

The nose shows plums and dark berries, with spicy undertones. The palate is all about silky tannins and length, bright flavours of plum and berries combined with the subtle tannins, makes this smooth on the finish.

**Kleine Zalze Cabernet Sauvignon 2019**

6 / 8 / 24

*Cabernet Sauvignon*

*Swartland*

From the Wellington vineyards, this deep-coloured, richly blackcurrant wine was made using a long skin maceration and matured in second and third-fill French oak.

**Nederburg The Motorcycle Marvel 2017**

32

*Grenache, Carignan, Shiraz*

*Western Cape*

Matured in barrels, some French oak, but all vintage, for about two years prior to bottling. Spicy hedgerow fruit on the nose, the palate is rich and intense with silky tannins.

### Spain

**Viña Real, Rioja Crianza 2018**

7 / 9.35 / 28

*Tempranillo, Garnacha*

*Rioja*

Ripe and richly fruity wine with rich aromas of fruit cake and spice, smooth and supple in the mouth with perfectly integrated oak, a rounded silky texture, and smooth tannins, all supported by a lovely weight of fruit.

**Viña Real, Rioja Gran Reserva 2014**

38

*Tempranillo, Garnacha*

*Rioja*

This stunning Rioja has the Viña Real hallmark of bright fruit. The nose is fragrant and enticing with ripe and dried fruit mingling with spice, cocoa, vanilla, and cedar wood. The palate is rich, structured and complex with smooth tannins.

## Rose Wines

### Argentina

**Portillo Malbec Rosé 2020**

6 / 8 / 24

*Malbec*

*Uco Valley, Mendoza*

Highly aromatic with its ruby-red hints, this rosé offers up fruit aromas of cherry, strawberry, and raspberry. Unoaked, the palate finishes crisply with lingering fruit notes.

### France

**Mirabeau Côtes de Provence Rosé Pure 2020**

32

*Cinsault, Grenache, Syrah*

*Provence*

Grenache blended with Syrah gives ripe cherry and raspberry flavours; a smattering of Vermentino provides delicate citrus flavours and herbaceous, white pepper hints. Dry and elegant, perfect for summertime.



## White Wines

### Chile

**Errázuriz Chardonnay** 2020 26  
*Chardonnay Casablanca Valley*  
 This tropical, lightly oaked Chardonnay is left to mature on the yeast lees before bottling to enhance complexity, giving a refreshing citrusy acidity that gives lift to the palate.

### France

**Jean-Luc Colombo Les Girelles** 2020 28  
*Picpoul Pinet, Languedoc*  
 These Picpoul grapes produce a full-bodied white wine with herbal and citrus aromas. A soft taste and delicate nose complement pleasant traits of acacia and hawthorn blossom.

**Joseph Mellot Les Collinettes Sancerre** 2019 36  
*Sauvignon Blanc Loire Valley*  
 Elegant and zesty, blackcurrant leaf and gooseberry character complement a minerally finish.

**Louis Jadot Chablis Cellier de la Sablière** 2020 36  
*Chardonnay Burgundy*  
 This very elegant Chardonnay is bursting with white flowers and stone fruit aromas. Round and subtle on the palate, this wine has a long finish with a stony character and a fresh acidity that leaves you wanting more.

**Emile Beyer Pinot Gris Alsace Tradition Organic** 2019 40  
*Pinot Gris Alsace*  
 Hand-harvested grapes from a single vineyard planted on limestone soils are employed to make this aromatic wine. This off dry, almost sweet wine shows smoky notes, yellow fruit such as peach and apricot beside bergamot aromas.

**Louis Jadot Pouilly-Fuissé Les Petites Pierres** 2018 44  
*Chardonnay Burgundy*  
 This delicate and distinctive wine is matured in French oak for 15 months to provide a dry Burgundy with notes of apple and citrus, and a long buttery finish.

**Domaines de Ladoucette Pouilly-Fumé** 2019 50  
*Sauvignon Blanc Loire Valley*  
 Elegant and zesty, an unrivalled level of expertise is translated into this beautifully intense Sauvignon Blanc. Mineral and concentrated with white-fruit, gooseberry, and flint flavours.

**Louis Jadot Meursault** 2016 65  
*Chardonnay Burgundy*  
 Louis Jadot vinifies their wine in oak barrels to produce a rich, rounded wine. Bold, rich, and creamy with complex butter, toasted vanilla, and tropical fruit notes.

### Germany

**Loosen Bros Dr L Riesling** 2020 30  
*Riesling Mosel*  
 Fresh and light with the classic Mosel raciness, it shows citrus fruits such as grapefruit and lime with mineral notes and a touch of spritz on the finish.

### Italy

**Fantinel Grave del Friuli Pinot Grigio** 2020 6.50 / 8.65 / 26  
*Pinot Grigio Friuli-Venezia Giulia*  
 A well-structured example of this ever-popular variety from the gravelly plains to the south of the eastern 'arm' of the Alps. A refreshing and flavoursome wine with ripe apple, peach, and pear notes.

**Torre dei Beati Giocheremo con I Fiori Pecorino** 2020 32  
*Chardonnay Abruzzo*  
 Unoaked with an elegant nose of pear, floral notes, and a touch of honey. The vibrant palate has citrus and herbaceous notes. This organic wine's name translates as 'We will play with flowers;' the owners' daughter painted the label.

### New Zealand

**LeftField Sauvignon Blanc** 2021 7 / 9.35 / 28  
*Sauvignon Blanc Nelson*  
 Strongly aromatic with a crisp vibrancy to the finish; it shows aromas of passion fruit, nectarine, and lemongrass alongside other green herbs. Light and mineral style with tropical flavours.

**Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc** 2021 36  
*Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough*  
 This intensely flavoured Sauvignon Blanc shows grassy and gooseberry aromas, with rich citrus and green fruit on the palate.

### Portugal

**Esporão Alandra Branco** 2019 6 / 8 / 24  
*Antao Vaz, Perrum Alentejo*  
 Deliciously zesty, this medium bodied, balanced blend of Portuguese grapes is shockingly good value. This lush number made from local varieties offers plenty of rich honeyed fruit for the price.

### South Africa

**Kleine Zalze Bush Vines Chenin Blanc** 2021 6 / 8 / 24  
*Chenin Blanc Swartland*  
 Produced from Low-yielding old 'bush vines', this dry Stellenbosch has high acidity and notes of tropical-fruit.

### Spain

**Raimat Saira Albariño Costers del Segre** 2020 28  
*Albariño Rias Baixas*  
 Shows delicate aromas of citrus, dried flowers, and spice with a hint of sweet vanilla and dried fruit. The palate is well-rounded with a citrusy and refreshing finish.

### Champagne & Sparkling

#### Conti D'Arco Prosecco Brut

5/30

Produced from grapes grown in the north-east of Italy, this wine is a classic Prosecco with an abundance of fizz and a wonderful palate of fresh apple, pear and just a hint of white peach.

#### Anna de Codorníu Blanc de Blancs Brut Reserva

34

Anna de Codorniu Cava has notes of citrus and tropical fruit with complex aromas of toasted brioche. These enrich the creamy, broad, and persistent aromatic palate.

#### Taittinger Brut Réserve, NV

11/55

Light, delicate, and elegant; dry, fresh, and balanced with a green fruit and citrus character. The blend is 40% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir, 25% Pinot Meunier; it receives three to four years ageing prior to release, this results in subtle hints of biscuit and brioche.

#### Laurent-Perrier La Cuvée Brut NV

65

Laurent-Perrier's style and personality are defined by its very high proportion of Chardonnay. Purity, freshness, and elegance – with notes of citrusy grapefruit and orange blossom.

#### Taittinger Prestige Rosé

70

This lively pink Champagne has crushed wild raspberry and cherry notes, with a creamy texture and subtle toasty flavours on the finish.

#### Dom Pérignon Brut Vintage 2012

220

Named after the Benedictine Monk Dom Pierre Perignon, this prestigious and legendary Champagne is a blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, aged for a minimum of 7 years on its lees. The result is a complex and elegant Champagne, with candied peel, nectarine, and toasted brioche with fine and delicate bubbles.
